We get very little funding from the county that goes towards marching band. We are a self-funded activity primarily through student band fees, donations, and sponsorships. We use donations to help cover our operating expenses, new equipment/instruments, new uniforms, and other items. We are looking at replacing one of our bands trailers and replacing several of our older instruments. Individually, these items can cost anywhere from 1000 to 2000 a piece, and of course a new enclosed 24ft trailer can be upwards of 5000. Please pass this information on to any businesses that you know also. We are happy to advertise for any local business with one of our sponsorship levels. I have attached one of our sponsorship forms. Advertisements range from a shoutout at football games to name and logo on our 28ft trailer that gets pulled across Eastern NC to Raleigh and sometimes beyond.
